RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Entrant must be at least 13 years of age but no more than 29 years of age by August 15, 2008. At each state and National Pageant, there are three age divisions: 13-15 years, 16-19 years, and 20-29 years.
2. In the 13-15 years and 16-19 years teen divisions, entrant must certify that she is not now and never has been married, has never had a marriage annulled, and has never given birth to a child. In the 20-29 years division, entrant can not be currently married, she may have been previously married. She may have given birth to a child.
3. Entrant may be a citizen, resident, or simply reside in the United States of America.
4. Entrant must be of good moral character.
5. If competing in a Perfect Teen or Miss State Pageant, entrant must have resided in that state for at least 6 months. Residence at a college of university is acceptable.
6. If there is no state pageant in the state where the entrant resides, she may be appointed by the National Office to hold the state title.
7. If an entrant from any state wishes to be appointed as a state titleholder to a state other than the one she resides, she may be appointed by the National Office. It is our intention to hold a state pageant in each of the 50 states and DC, until then, the National Office reserves the right to appoint state delegates in any way they see fit.
